There was no appearance by or on behalf of the respondent and the Tribunal is satisfied that she was properly notified of the hearing.

Appellant's case

The appellant stated that he commenced employment with the respondent on 17th April 2006 and was let go when the business closed down on 10th September 2010. At the time of termination of employment the appellant was being paid €520.00 gross per week. The appellant did not receive notice of redundancy or payment in lieu thereof or any payment from the respondent in respect of a lump sum redundancy payment.

Determination

Having considered the uncontested evidence of the appellant the Tribunal awards him €1,040.00 under the Minimum Notice and Terms of Employment Acts, 1973 to 2005 and a lump sum redundancy payment under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007 based on the following criteria.

Termination date	10 th September 2010
Gross pay	€520.00 per week
