At the outset of the hearing the claim under the Minimum Notice and Terms of Employment Acts, 1973 to 2005 was withdrawn.

### **Determination:**

The Tribunal is satisfied that the respondent was duly notified of the hearing. Neither the respondent nor a representative on their behalf appeared at this hearing.
