Determination

The respondent company is in liquidation; the Tribunal are satisfied that they are properly on notice of this hearing. The claimant gave sworn evidence that she was dismissed without notice from her employment on the 23rd of February 2010. The claimant gave evidence of loss and her attempts to mitigate her loss.

The Tribunal find that the claim under the Unfair Dismissals Acts 1977 to 2007 succeeds and awards the claimant €5,000.00 as compensation.

The Tribunal award the claimant €562.00 being the equivalent to 2 weeks' pay in lieu of notice under the Minimum Notice and Terms of Employment Acts, 1973 to 2005.
