Appellant's case

The appellant stated that he commenced employment with the respondent on 17th April 2006 and was let go when the business closed down on 12th February 2010. At the time of termination of employment the appellant was being paid €550.00 gross per week. The appellant did not receive any payment from the respondent in respect of a lump sum redundancy payment.

Determination

Having considered the uncontested evidence of the appellant the Tribunal awards him a lump sum redundancy payment under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007 based on the following criteria.

Date notice received	29 th January 2010
Termination date	12 th February 2010
Gross pay	€550.00 per week
