The respondent conceded that a redundancy situation existed. The Tribunal awards the appellants a redundancy lump sum under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2003 based on the following criteria:

This award is made subject to the appellant having been in insurable employment under the Social Welfare Acts during the relevant period. It should be noted that a statutory weekly ceiling of $\in 600.00$ applies to payments from the Social Insurance Fund.

The Tribunal awards the first named appellant €2710.36 being the equivalent of four week's pay and the second named appellant €863.84 being the equivalent of two's week's pay under the Minimum Notice and Terms of Employment Acts, 1973 to 2005.
