### **Background**

It was common case that the appellant commenced employment with the respondent on 28th November 2005 and was made redundant, without notice, on 21st February 2011. The business was closed by the Revenue Commissioners and no notice was given.

### **Determination**

Having considered the evidence adduced the Tribunal awards *appellant 1* a lump sum redundancy payment under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007 based on the following criteria.

Termination date 21st February 2011

Gross pay €273.00
