### Determination

The Tribunal is satisfied that the respondent was properly notified of the hearing. Neither the respondent nor a representative on their behalf attended the hearing.

The Tribunal is satisfied based on the uncontested evidence of the appellant that he was dismissed by reason of redundancy. Accordingly the Tribunal awards him a redundancy lump sum payment under the Redundancy Payments Acts 1967 to 2007 based on the following information:

Date of Birth: 20<sup>th</sup> September 1970  
Date of commencement of employment: 15<sup>th</sup> June 2001  
Date of termination of employment: 27<sup>th</sup> July 2010  
Gross weekly pay: €744.92

This award is made subject to the appellant having been in insurable employment under the Social Welfare Acts during the relevant period.

It should be noted that payments from the social insurance fund are limited to a maximum of €600 per week.
