This case came before the Tribunal by way of employees seeking implementation of the Recommendations of the Rights Commissioner under the Terms of Employment (Information) Acts, 1994 and 2001 Ref: (r-081265-te-09/GC, r-081247-te-09/GC)

The decision of the Tribunal was as follows:

Determination

The Tribunal, is satisfied that the recommendations of the Rights Commissioner made under section 7 of the Terms of Employment Act 1994 to 2001 has not been carried out by the employer/respondent in accordance with its terms or at all and it is further satisfied that the prescribed six-week time limit for bringing an appeal against the recommendation has expired and no such appeal has been brought. Accordingly, the Tribunal makes a determination to like effect as the Rights Commissioner's recommendation that the respondent pays the first named appellant €100.00 and the second named appellant €100.00 under the Terms of Employment (Information) Act, 1994 and 2001.
