Determination

The Tribunal is satisfied that all parties were properly notified of the hearing and noted also that the respondent company is dissolved since the 23rd September 2011. As there was no appearance by or on behalf of the respondent and based on the uncontested evidence of the appellant the Tribunal finds that she was dismissed by reason of redundancy.

The Tribunal awards the appellant a lump sum payment under the Redundancy Payments Acts 1967 to 2007 based on the following information:

Date of Birth - 19 February 1961 Date of Commencement - 5 January 2007 Date of Termination - 16 November 2010

Weekly Gross Pay - €323.01

This award is made subject to the appellant having been in insurable employment under the

Social Welfare Acts during the relevant period.

The Tribunal allows the claim under the Minimum Notice and Terms of Employment Acts, 1973 to 2005 and award the appellant €646.02 as compensation for two weeks pay.

The appeal under the Organisation of Working Time Act, 1997 is allowed and the appellant is awarded €323.01.
