The appellant told the Tribunal that he was made redundant by the respondent company on 20th March 2010. He received a redundancy cheque on the 8th December 2010. The appellant told the Tribunal that he did not receive his full statutory entitlement under the Redundancy Payments Acts 1967 to 2007 due to a miscalculation of his average hours by the respondent company.

Determination
