The decision of the Tribunal was as follows:-

As there was no appearance by *Appellants 1, 2, 3, and 5* their appeals under the Redundancy Payment's Acts 1967 to 2007 are dismissed for lack of prosecution.

Based on the uncontested evidence of *Appellant 4* the Tribunal finds that the appeal under the Redundancy Payments Acts 1967 to 2007 succeeds and makes an award based on the following criteria;

Appellant 4

Employment Started: 31st May 2007
Employment Ended: 12th September 2011
Gross Pay: €680.00

It should be noted that payments from the Social Insurance Fund are limited to a maximum of €600.00 per week.

This award is made subject to the appellant having been in insurable employment under the Social Welfare Acts during the relevant period.
