Determination

The Tribunal heard evidence from *appellant 2* concerning the circumstances surrounding the termination of his employment. This evidence was not contested by the respondent's representative. The Tribunal is satisfied on the basis of the appellant's evidence that he was dismissed by reason of redundancy and accordingly awards the appellant a lump sum payment under the Redundancy Payments Acts 1967 to 2007 based on the following information:

Date of Birth: 14th January 1963
Date of commencement of employment: 10th October 2008
Date of termination of employment: 09th September 2011

Gross weekly pay: €448.50

The Tribunal is satisfied that *appellant 2* received his Minimum Notice and therefore the appeal under the Minimum Notice and Terms of Employment Acts 1973 to 2005 fails.

The Tribunal heard evidence from <i>appellant 1</i> concerning the circumstances surrounding the termination of his employment. This evidence was contested by the respondent's representative. The Tribunal is not satisfied that <i>appellant 1</i> was dismissed by reason of redundancy and prefersthe evidence of the respondent that the appellant had already sought and obtained work prior to hisdate of leaving. Accordingly the claim under the Redundancy Payments Acts 1967 to 2007 and Minimum Notice and Terms of Employment Acts, 1973 to 2005 fails.
