The claims were conceded by the respondent.

Determination:

The Tribunal finds that the appellant is entitled to a lump sum payment under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007, based on the following criteria:

Date of Birth:	4 October 1950
Date of Commencement:	26 June 2006
Period of non-reckonable service:	6 October 2010 to 29 April 2011
Date of Termination:	29 April 2011
Gross Weekly Pay:	€567.15

This award is made subject to the appellant having been in insurable employment under the Social Welfare Acts during the relevant period.

The Tribunal is satisfied that the appellant is entitled to the sum of €1,134.30 (being the

equivalent of two weeks' gross pay) under the Minimum Notice and Terms of Employment Acts, 1973 to 2005.
