This award is subject to the appellant having been in employment which is insurable for all purposes under the Social Welfare Consolidation Act 2005.

The Tribunal finds that the appellant is entitled to the sum of €727.06 under the Minimum Notice and Terms of Employment Acts, 1973 to 2005, (this being the equivalent of two weeks' pay).
