The decision of the Tribunal was as follows:-

Determination

On the day of the hearing the Tribunal received correspondence from the respondent's representative conceding the claimant's entitlement to a redundancy payment under the Redundancy Payments Acts 1967 to 2007.

Accordingly, the Tribunal finds that the claimant is entitled to a lump sum payment under the Redundancy Payments Acts 1967 to 2007 based on the following criteria:
