The decision of the Tribunal was as follows:-

The appellant claimed that his employment, which commenced on 31 August 2007, ended by reason of redundancy on 31 March 2010. His gross weekly pay was €653.00. .

The respondent did not dispute the appellant's entitlement to a redundancy lump sum.

**Determination:**

Under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007, the Tribunal finds that the appellant is entitled to a redundancy lump sum based on the following details:

Date of birth:	6 January 1971
Date of commencement:	31 August 2007
Date of termination:	31 March 2010
Gross weekly pay:	€653.00

It should be noted that payments from the Social Insurance Fund are limited to a maximum of €600.00 per week.

This award is made subject to the appellant having been in insurable employment under the Social Welfare Acts during the relevant period.
