The decision of the Tribunal was as follows:-

Appellant 1

On the uncontested evidence of appellant 1, the Tribunal finds that the appellant is entitled to a redundancy lump sum payment under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007, based on the following criteria:

Employment commenced14th May 2007Employment ended30th September 2010Gross weekly pay€1000.00The Tribunal awards the appellant his statutory entitlement of €2,000.00, being the sum due for twoweeks' notice, under the Minimum Notice and Terms of Employment Acts, 1973 to 2005.

This award is made subject to the appellant having been in insurable employment under the Social Welfare Acts during the relevant period. It should be noted that payments from the social insurance fund are limited to a maximum of $\in 600-00$ per week.

Appellant 2

On the uncontested evidence of the appellant, the Tribunal finds that the appellant is entitled to a redundancy lump sum payment under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007, based on the following criteria:

Employment commenced	14 th May 2007
Employment ended	30 th September 2010
Gross weekly pay	€816.00

This award is made subject to the appellant having been in insurable employment under the Social Welfare Acts during the relevant period. It should be noted that payments from the social insurance fund are limited to a maximum of \notin 600-00 per week

The Tribunal awards the appellant his statutory entitlement of €1,632.00, being the sum due for four weeks' notice, under the Minimum Notice and Terms of Employment Acts, 1973 to 2005.
