The decision of the Tribunal was as follows:-

The respondent's representative explained that a redundancy situation occurred in relation to the appellant's position when the respondent ceased trading. He consented to the appellant attaching an appeal under the Minimum Notice and Terms of Employment Acts, 1973 to 2005. The representative conceded the appeals under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007and Minimum Notice and Terms of Employment Acts, 1973 to 2005.

## **Determination:**

The Tribunal is satisfied that a redundancy situation occurred and that the appellant is entitled to a redundancy lump sum payment under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007, based on the following information:

Date of Birth:19th April 1959Date of Commencement:2nd February 2007Date of Termination:18th October 2010Weekly Gross Pay:€546.00

This award is made subject to the appellant having been in insurable employment under the Social Welfare Acts during the relevant period.

The Tribunal also awards the appellant €1,092.00 (one thousand and ninety-two Euro) in respect of two weeks' pay under the Minimum Notice and Terms of Employment Acts, 1973 to 2005.
