At the outset the claim under the Redundancy Payments Acts was withdrawn when the claimant advised the Tribunal that he had received his entitlements under those Acts.

Being satisfied that the respondent was properly on notice of the hearing, the Tribunal finds, based on the uncontroverted evidence, that the claimant is entitled to an award of €958-34, being two weeks’ pay under the Minimum Notice and Terms of Employment Acts, 1973 to 2005.
