The decision of the Tribunal was as follows:-

The appellant claimed that her employment, which commenced on 4 April 2003, ended by reason of redundancy on 24 March 2010. Her gross weekly pay was €86.50.

No evidence was offered by or on behalf of the respondent to dispute the appellant's entitlement to a redundancy lump sum payment.

**Determination:**

Under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007, the Tribunal finds that the appellant is entitled to a redundancy lump sum based on the following details:

Date of birth:	4 July 1944
Date of commencement:	4 April 2003
Date of termination:	24 March 2010
Gross weekly pay:	€86.50

This award is made subject to the appellant having been in insurable employment under the Social Welfare Acts during the relevant period.
