#### **Determination**

The decision of the Tribunal was as follows:-

The respondent stated that he completed an RP50 form for the appellant on the 15<sup>th</sup> January 2010 which his accountant submitted and to date he has not received his redundancy monies.

The Tribunal finds that the appellant is entitled to a redundancy lump sum payment under the Redundancy Payments Acts 1967 to 2007 based on the following:-

Date employment ended	29 <sup>th</sup> January 2010
Gross weekly pay	€286.10
