The decision of the Tribunal was as follows:-

The first-named claimant (MF) claimed that his employment, which commenced on 4

September 2003, ended without notice on 12 June 2008. His gross weekly pay was €1,500.00.

The second-named claimant (KC) also claimed that his employment, which commenced on 4 September 2003, ended without notice on 12 June 2008. His gross weekly pay was €1,500.00.

No evidence was offered by or on behalf of the respondent to dispute the claimants' entitlement to minimum notice payments.

Determination:

Allowing the claims lodged under the Minimum Notice and Terms of Employment Acts, 1973 to 2005, the Tribunal awards the first-name claimant (MF) the sum of €3,000.00 (this amount being equivalent to two weeks' gross pay at €1,500.00 per week) and also awards the second-named claimant (KC) the sum of €3,000.00 (this amount being equivalent to two weeks' gross pay at €1,500.00 per week) under the said Minimum Notice and Terms of Employment Acts, 1973 to 2005.
