The decision of the Tribunal was as follows:

The Parties came before the Tribunal on an employer appeal from a decision of the Rights Commissioners dated the 24th August 2009 (r-052594-pw-07/JT and r-052592-te-07/JT).

The appellant stated that one month's notice had been paid to the respondent, who worked for a period of eight months. No wages were outstanding and no payslips were available. The respondent was not given a written contract or any written confirmation of his terms of employment.

Determination

The Tribunal is satisfied that Terms of Employment were not issued to the respondent as per Section 3 of the Terms of Employment (Information) Acts, 1994 to 2001 and varies the Rights

Commissioner award to \in 500. As the respondent did not attend to present any argument to the contrary, the Tribunal overturns the decision of the Rights Commissioner under the Payment of Wages Act, 1991 and the appeal succeeds.
