Determination

The Tribunal find that by his own evidence the appellant received his redundancy payment; consequently his appeal under the Redundancy Payments Acts 1967 to 2007 is dismissed. The appellant served the RP9, intention to claim redundancy form on the respondent, therefore precluding him from a minimum notice entitlement under the Minimum Notice and Terms of Employment Acts 1973 to 2005.
