The Tribunal finds, based on the uncontroverted evidence, that the appellant is entitled to a lump sum payment under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007 based on the following criteria.

Employment ended	30 th April 2010
Gross weekly pay	€600
This award is made subject to the appellant having been in insurable employment under the Social Welfare Acts during the relevant period. It should be noted that payments from the social insurance fund are limited to a maximum of ϵ 600-00 per week.	
The appeal under the Minimum Notice and Terms of Employment Acts, 1973 to 2005 is allowed and the appellant is awarded the sum of €1,200 being 2 weeks gross pay.
