The decision of the Tribunal was as follows:

Preliminary Issue

The Tribunal heard evidence concerning question of which of 5 inter-related companies was the appellant's employer at the time he was made redundant. Having considered the evidence from both parties the Tribunal finds that the above named respondent was the appellant's employer and that the responsibility for paying the appellant's redundancy falls on it.

Determination

The Tribunal accepted that a redundancy situation existed following a sharp downturn in the respondent's business. The appellant is awarded a redundancy lump sum under the RedundancyPayments Acts, 1977 to 2007, based on the following information:
