At the outset of the hearing the appeal under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007 was withdrawn.

Determination:

The Tribunal is satisfied that the respondent was duly notified of the hearing. Neither the respondent nor a representative on his behalf appeared at the hearing.

Based on the uncontested evidence of the appellant, the Tribunal finds that he is entitled to €400.00 being the equivalent of two weeks notice under the Minimum Notice and Terms of Employment Acts, 1973 to 2005.
