The decision of the Tribunal was as follows:-

This case came to the Tribunal as an employee appeal under the Payment of Wages Act, 1991, against Rights Commissioner Decision r-090448-pw-10.

At the Tribunal hearing it was alleged that the appellant was owed by the respondent the sum of $\notin 1,500.00$ in arrears of wages and holiday pay. The written appeal stated appellant's gross weekly pay to have been $\notin 585.00$. The respondent's representative told the Tribunal that shehad been asked by a respondent director (KC) to say that the respondent was dissolved and nottrading and that she was not instructed to contest the appeal.

Determination:

As the appeal against Rights Commissioner Decision r-090448-pw-10 was uncontested the Tribunal allows the said appeal and orders that the respondent pay to the appellant the sum of \notin 1,500.00 (this amount being equivalent to 2.5641025 weeks' gross pay at \notin 585.00 per week) under the Payment of Wages Act, 1991.
