The decision of the Tribunal was as follows:-

The appellant claimed that his employment, which commenced on 8 December 2005, ended by reason of redundancy on 19 July 2010. His gross weekly pay was €550.00.

The respondent's principal told the Tribunal that he had given a van to the appellant but the principal did not indicate that any monetary payment had been made to the appellant for redundancy.

Determination:

Under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007, the Tribunal finds that the appellant is entitled to a redundancy lump sum based on the following details:

Date of birth:	1 December 1964
Date of commencement:	8 December 2005
Date of termination:	19 July 2010
Gross weekly pay:	€550.00

This award is made subject to the appellant having been in insurable employment under the Social Welfare Acts during the relevant period.
