The decision of the Tribunal was as follows:

In the case of *appellant A*, the appeal under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007 was withdrawn. The appeal under the Minimum Notice and Terms of Employment Acts, 1973 to 2005 is allowed and the appellant is awarded €1,753.00, being the equivalent of four weeks' pay, as compensation under those Acts.

The Tribunal is satisfied that *appellant B* was properly notified of this hearing. Neither the appellant nor a representative on her behalf appeared for this hearing.

Accordingly, the appeals related to this appellant under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007, and the Minimum Notice and Terms of Employment Acts, 1973 to 2005 fall for want of prosecution.
