The decision of the Tribunal was as follows:-

The appellant claimed that his employment, which commenced on 16 March 2007, ended by reason of redundancy on 6 January 2010. His gross weekly pay was €337.35.

No evidence was offered by or on behalf of the respondent to dispute the appellant's entitlement to a redundancy lump sum.

Determination:

Under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007, the Tribunal finds that the appellant is entitled to a redundancy lump sum based on the following details:

Date of birth:	17 July 1961
Date of commencement:	16 March 2007
Date of termination:	06 January 2010
Gross weekly pay:	€337.35

This award is made subject to the appellant having been in insurable employment under the Social Welfare Acts during the relevant period.
