The appellant claimed that his employment, which commenced on 29 March 2006, ended by reason of redundancy in November 2010. His gross weekly pay was €350.00.

No evidence was offered by the respondent at the hearing to dispute the appellant's entitlement to a redundancy lump sum. The respondent provided a document from his accountants confirming that the respondent was not in any financial position to pay the redundancy due to the appellant.
