### **Determination:**

The Tribunal has considered the time limit for receipt of appeals under Section 24 of the Redundancy Payments Act 1967 as amended by Section 12 of the Redundancy Payments Act 1971 and Section 13 of the Redundancy Payments Act 1979 and has decided to allow the appellant to present his case.

The Tribunal is satisfied that the respondent was duly notified of the hearing. Neither the respondent nor a representative on their behalf appeared at the hearing.

The Tribunal finds that the appellant was dismissed by reason of redundancy and is entitled to a redundancy payment based on:
