The determination of the Tribunal was as follows:-

Preliminary Issue:

The claimant was employed as a Pro-Rata Part-time Teacher of Irish. A preliminary issue was raised as to whether the claimant was covered by the Unfair Dismissals Acts, 1977 to 2007.

Section 2 (1) (j) of the Unfair Dismissals Acts, 1977 states:

“ This Act shall not apply in relation to any of the following persons:

(j) officers of a health board, a vocational education committee by the Vocational Education Act, 1930 or a committee of agriculture established by the Agriculture Act, 1931.”

Determination:

Having carefully considered the submissions made and read the relevant section of the Act, the Tribunal finds they have no jurisdiction to claim the claim. The claim under the Unfair Dismissals Acts, 1977 to 2007 fails.
