The decision of the Tribunal was as follows:-

Determination

The Tribunal heard evidence from both parties who confirmed that the appellant's employment was terminated by reason of redundancy. The respondent received 60% rebate from the Social Insurance Fund in respect of the appellant's redundancy. However the appellant did not receive his full statutory entitlement under the Redundancy Payments Acts 1967 to 2007 and is seeking payment of the 40% outstanding.

Accordingly, the Tribunal finds that the appellant is entitled to a lump sum payment under the Redundancy Payments Acts 1967 to 2007 based on the following criteria:

Date of Birth: 21st July 1981
Date of commencement: 23rd February 2004
Date of Termination: 30th January 2009

Gross Pay: €532.17
