Determination

The Tribunal are satisfied that the respondent was properly put on notice of this hearing. Based on the uncontested evidence of the appellants, the Tribunal finds that they were dismissed by reason of redundancy.

The Tribunal awards the appellants a lump sum payment under the Redundancy Payments Acts 1967 to 2007 based on the following information:

These awards are made subject to the appellants having been in insurable employment under the Social Welfare Acts during the relevant period.

The Tribunal allows the claim under the Minimum Notice and Terms of Employment Acts, 1973 to 2005 and awards *appellant 1* €761.20 being the equivalent to 4 weeks' pay in lieu of notice and *appellant 2* €761.20 being the equivalent to 4 weeks' pay in lieu of notice.
