Determination:

Having heard the uncontested evidence of the appellant the Tribunal finds that the appellant's employment was terminated by way of redundancy. Accordingly, the appeal under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007 is allowed and is awarded a statutory lump sum under those Acts, and based on the following:

Date of Birth: 18th September 1952

Date of Commencement: 15th September 2003

Date of Termination: 18th September 2010

Gross Weekly Wage: €750.00

This award is made subject to the appellant having been in insurable employment during the relevant period in accordance with the Social Welfare Acts. It should be noted that a statutory weekly ceiling of € 600.00 currently applies to payments from the Social Insurance Fund.
