Determination

The appellant's date of termination of employment was 3 January 2009 and the appeal was lodged with the Tribunal secretariat on 13 May 2011. Appeals under the Redundancy Payments Acts 1967 to 2007 must be submitted to the secretariat of the Tribunal within fifty-two weeks of the date of termination of employment. Appeals lodged after the aforesaid period but within the period of one hundred and four weeks from the date of dismissal may be considered, subject to the appellant demonstrating reasonable cause for the delay in furnishing such an application within the time limit. As the appeal was lodged outside of the period of one hundred and four weeks from the date of dismissal the Tribunal finds that it has no jurisdiction and in those circumstances the appeal fails.
