The decision of the Tribunal was as follows:

Having heard and considered the circumstances of these cases and noting that the respondent was not contesting the appeals, the Tribunal finds that the employment of both appellants were terminated by the respondent by way of redundancy. Accordingly, the appeals under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007 are allowed and each appellant is awarded a statutory redundancy payment under the above Acts, and based on the following:
