## **Determination:**

At the outset both claims under the Minimum Notice and Terms of Employment Acts, 1973 to 2005 were withdrawn.

In circumstances where the respondent has ceased trading and did not seek to contest the appeals the Tribunal finds that the appellants are entitled to lump sum payments under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007 based on the following criteria.
