### The decision of the Tribunal was as follows:

Mr. B informed the Tribunal that the company is in liquidation. The claimant's case is that hedid not receive notice of the termination of his employment nor payment in lieu of that notice. In addition the claimant is owed the sum of  $\mathfrak{C}2,767$  in relation to outstanding holiday pay.

## **Determination:**

The Tribunal finds that the claimant is entitled to the sum of €2,596.92 (being the equivalent of four weeks' gross pay) under the Minimum Notice and Terms of Employment Acts, 1973 to 2005.

The Tribunal also finds that the claimant is entitled to the sum of  $\in 2,767$  (being the equivalent of 21.3 days gross pay) under the Organisation of Working Time Act, 1997.
