Claimant's case

At the outset the appellant withdrew his appeal under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007. The claimant stated that he was made redundant by the respondent on 25th February 2011. He received notice of only one week and was claiming the balance of his statutory entitlement.

The appellant was employed by the respondent from 1st October 2000 to 25th February 2011. At the time of his dismissal he was earning €620.46 per week.

Determination

Having considered the uncontested evidence of the claimant the Tribunal awards him €3,102.30 under the Minimum Notice and Terms of Employment Acts, 1973 to 2005.
