Determination

The Tribunal is satisfied based on the evidence of the appellant that she was dismissed by reason of redundancy. Accordingly the Tribunal awards her a redundancy lump sum payment under the Redundancy Payments Acts 1967 to 2007 based on the following information:

Date of Birth:	2 nd November 1955
Date of commencement of employment:	14th March 2007
Date of termination of employment:	31st December 2009
Gross weekly pay:	€450.00

Loss having been established the Tribunal awards the appellant compensation of €900.00 which is equivalent to two week's gross pay under the Minimum Notice and Terms of Employment Acts, 1973 to 2005.

The Tribunal also determines that the claimant is entitled to a further payment of €1,800.00 being the equivalent of four weeks holiday pay under the Organisation of Working Time Act1997.

These awards are made subject to the appellant having been in insurable employment under the Social Welfare Acts during the relevant period.
