At the outset of the hearing the appeals under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007 were withdrawn.

Determination:

The Tribunal is satisfied that the respondent was duly notified of the hearing. Neither the respondent nor a representative on his behalf appeared at the hearing.

Based on the uncontested evidence of *appellant a*, the Tribunal finds that he is entitled to €2600.00 being the equivalent of eight weeks notice under the Minimum Notice and Terms of Employment Acts, 1973 to 2005.

Based on the uncontested evidence of *appellant b*, the Tribunal finds that he is entitled to €2250.00 being the equivalent of six weeks notice under the Minimum Notice and Terms of Employment Acts, 1973 to 2005.
