The determination of the Tribunal was as follows:-

At the outset of the hearing the claims under the Unfair Dismissals Acts, 1977 to 2007 and the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007 were withdrawn.

Determination

The claimant told the Tribunal that he was employed as a plasterer from November 2007 until the 25th February 2010. He was told on the 25th February 2010 there was no more work for him and he was not given notice that his employment was going to be terminated.

On the uncontested evidence of the claimant the Tribunal finds that he is entitled to compensation in lieu of notice in the amount of €1,322.00 which is equivalent to two weeks

gross pay (€661.00 per week).

There is a weekly ceiling of €600.00 on all awards made from the Social Insurance Fund.

As the claims under the Unfair Dismissals Acts 1977 to 2007 and the Redundancy Payments Acts 1967 to 2007 were withdrawn no awards are being made under these Acts
