The Tribunal allows the claim under the Minimum Notice and Terms of Employment Acts, 1973 to 2005 and awards appellant $1 \in 761.20$ being the equivalent to 4 weeks' pay in lieu of notice and appellant $2 \in 761.20$ being the equivalent to 4 weeks' pay in lieu of notice.
