## **Background**

It was common case that the appellant commenced employment with the respondent on 5<sup>th</sup> November 1990 and was made redundant on 30<sup>th</sup> April 2010. At the date of termination of employment the appellant was earning €814.42 per week.

The respondent is unable to pay the redundancy lump sum due to financial constraints.

## **Determination**

Having considered the evidence adduced the Tribunal awards the appellant a lump sum redundancy payment under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007 based on the following criteria.

DOB	3 <sup>rd</sup> November 1966

Commencement Date	5 <sup>th</sup> November 1990
Date notice received	N/A
Termination date	30 <sup>th</sup> April 2010
Gross pay	€814.42 per week

This award is made subject to the claimant having been in insurable employment, during the relevant period, in accordance with the Social Welfare Acts.

It should be noted that any payment made through the Social Insurance Fund is calculated based on maximum earnings of  $\epsilon$ 600.00 per week.
