The decision of the Tribunal was as follows:-

The appeal under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007 was withdrawn prior to the hearing.

Determination

The appellant's employment terminated without notice on the 2nd December 2009. The Tribunal finds that he is entitled to compensation in lieu of notice in the amount of €1,322.04 which is equivalent to two weeks gross pay (€661.02 per week) under the Minimum Notice and Terms of Employment Acts, 1973 to 2005.

As the appeal under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007 was withdrawn prior to the hearing no award is being made under this Act.

There is a weekly ceiling of €600.00 on all awards made from the Social Insurance Fund.
