Appellant's case

The appellant commenced employment with the respondent on 10th June 2008. She was advised on 3rd November 2010 that the 4th November would be her last day at work. As a teacher she was laid off from April – June 2009 but at no time exceeded a period of 26 weeks

Determination:

Having considered the uncontested evidence of the appellant the Tribunal awards her a lump sum redundancy payment under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007 based on the following criteria.

DOB 14th May 1985 Commencement Date 10th June 2008

Lay-off 24th April 2009 to 22nd June 2009

Date notice received 03rd November 2010
Termination date 04th November 2010
Gross pay €255.00 per week

This award is made subject to the claimant having been in insurable employment, during the relevant period, in accordance with the Social Welfare Acts.

The Tribunal also awards the appellant the sum of €510.00 (being the equivalent of two weeks gross pay) under the Minimum Notice and Terms of Employment Acts, 1973 to 2005.
