Background

It was common case that the appellant commenced employment with the respondent on 1st September 2006 and was made redundant on 30th June 2010. At the date of termination of employment the appellant was earning €252.04 per week.

The respondent is unable to pay the redundancy lump sum due to financial constraints.

Determination

Having considered the evidence adduced the Tribunal awards the appellant a lump sum redundancy payment under the Redundancy Payments Acts, 1967 to 2007 based on the following criteria.

Termination date	30 th June 2010
Gross pay	€252.04 per week
